
# Why? ECF4CLIM Project aim

Through a multidisciplinary, transdisciplinary and participatory process ECF4CLIM develops, tests and validates a European Competence Framework (ECF) for transformational change, which will empower the educational community to take action against climate change and towards sustainable development.



# What? ECF4CLIM specific objectives

To strength **individual** (knowledge, skills, attitudes) **and collective** (practices and social norms) **competences** in the areas of the climate change and sustainable development, we envision <u>4 lines of action</u>:



- 1. <u>Co-design</u> the ECF: identifying challenges & opportunities with schools & universities (individual & collective competences)
- 2. <u>Test</u> the ECF: a variety of contextually adapted interventions at our demonstration sites (environmental & behavioural)
- 3. <u>Engage in the ECF evaluation</u>: the broader educational community (individual & collective drivers and barriers)
- 4. <u>Empower</u> the broader educational community to trigger and sustain transformational change towards a more sustainable future.

### How? ECF4CLIM methods


- ✓ An innovative hybrid conceptual and methodological participatory approach combining elements from a variety of disciplines
  - →participatory action research
  - →citizen science
  - →citizen engagement
  - →theory-based stakeholder evaluation
  - $\rightarrow$ ...



### **✓** Monitoring and evaluation methods:

- →environmental performance (environmental sciences): LCA, KPI, IoT solutions for real-time monitoring, Dynamic building energy performance tool..
- →individual & collective performance (social sciences): semi-structured interviews, short surveys, secondary data analysis ...






