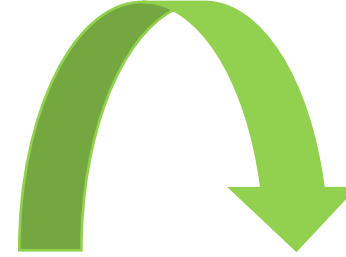

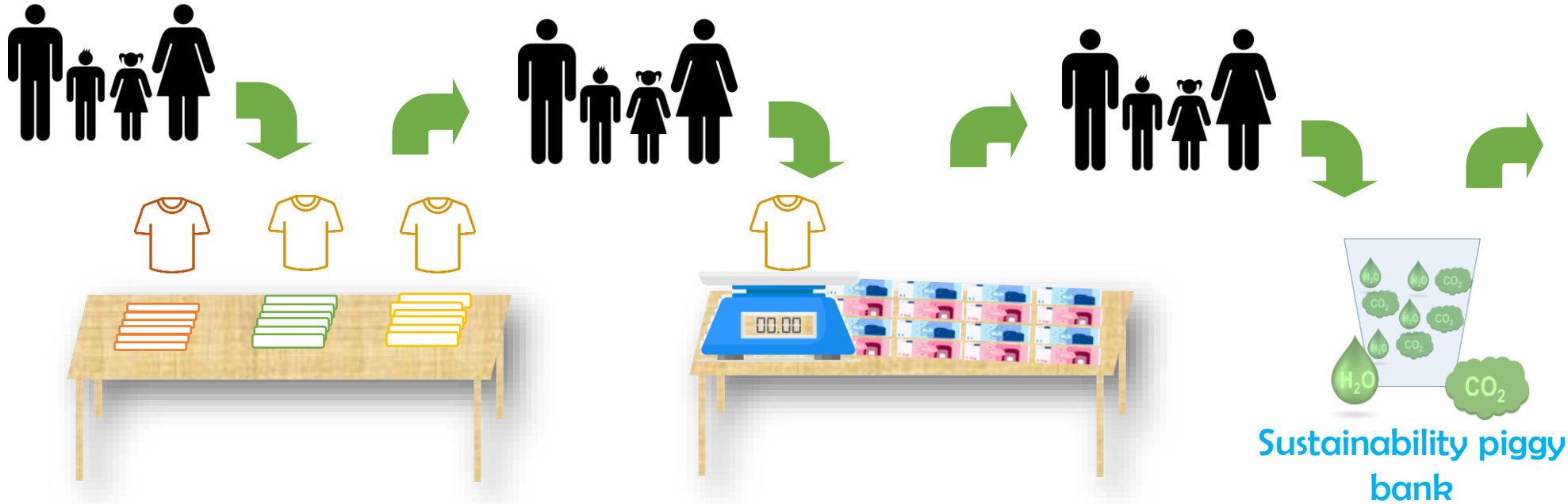

sustainable garment!!



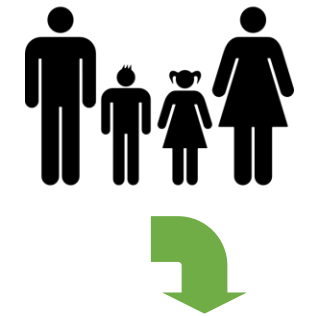
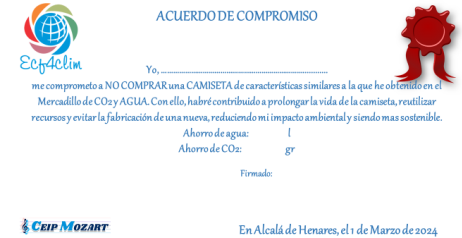
1) Place **your clothes** on the **exchange tables**

3) Go to the sustainability bench, weigh your new garment and collect your **CO<sub>2</sub>** and **H<sub>2</sub>O** savings

4) Deposit your savings **CO<sub>2</sub>** and **Water** in the **sustainability piggy bank**

5) Sign your Commitment Agreement:  
**You won't buy a new one.**
